



Rules and regulations for the use of the tennis courts

Reservation system Balle Jaune

With the introduction of this system in february 2021, every member received a password for the login, as well as a personalized 5 digit code, per email. This code enables, after reservation of a court, admission to the premises. Every new member will receive, after contribution of the annual fee, this access data per email.

- you may book a maximum of 2 consecutive hours (from 7:00 a.m. to 5:59 p.m.)

In times of huge demand however, this regulation may be reduced again to one hour.

-starting at 6:00 p.m. you may only book one hour.

-one may only make a booking with another member or a guest.

Tickets for guests may be purchased (6 Euros/1 hour). Momentarily the guest tickets (max. 5 tickets at a time) may be ordered at contact@tcmw.lu and the equivalent amount is to be paid to one of the club's banking accounts. The paid tickets will be credited online to your Balle Jaune account. It is possible to book one more hour after your initial reservation finished, even if it's the one directly following, should there still be a vacancy.

Participants in a tournament organized by the club (i.e. right now the Wantertournoi) will be given an additional time slot.

The board reserves the right to block the tennis courts for championships, tennis school, coaching, tournaments etc.

Very important:

If you cannot play, please release the booked hours as soon as possible (online cancelation), so they may be used by other club members instantly.

You are allowed to play only after a reservation, even if the court was not in use. The board needs exact information on the court bookings to function!

Deliberate incorrect bookings will not be tolerated and will result in the respective user accounts being blocked for a limited period of time.

Should the annual fee not have been payed by March 31st of the current year, the online access will be blocked until receipt of payment.

CARE OF THE TENNIS COURTS

Entering the tennis courts is only allowed wearing tennis shoes.

Before play, the courts must be watered. This is to be repeated should the surface turn too dry. In case of use of the water hoses, please put them back properly. Each court has its own hose. Please don't use the hose from court number 1 on court number 2.

5 minutes before the end of the hour, the outgoing players must use a net to level the court and a brush to clean the lines. The nets and brushes are to be hanged on the supports provided. After a doubles match, the poles are to be put back on the designated spots under the net.

The tennis courts, as well as their surroundings are to be kept clean.

A shirt must be worn at all times.

Smoking and pets are forbidden on the tennis courts.

MISCELLANEOUS

The board can close the courts for bad weather conditions as well as for maintenance and repair work.

No responsibility is taken for forgotten, lost or stolen objects.

The board is not liable for any physical damage incurred by a player on the premises.

Major damage to the pitch should be reported immediately per email at contact@tcmw.lu

Further complaints may be submitted in writing to the president of the board.

The members of the board ensure that these regulations are observed; their instructions are to be obeyed.

In the event of repeated violations, the board can resolve to expel the member(s) concerned.
